Dear Friends of IPM,

What a blessing it is to share God's truth with fellow believers. God's desire is to perfect our Christian walk as we grow in knowing Him. Our appreciation gift book for this month is *How to be Perfect*, by Andrew Murray. It is one of the outstanding biblical edification books that the Lord allows us to send regularly to believing inmates who write us, desiring to grow in their Christian walk.

No doubt we have all heard this statement: "nobody is perfect." This fully agrees with the word of God. *"As it is written: There is none righteous, no, not one . . . for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"* (Romans 3:10, 23). Multitudes of inmates have become personally (even painfully) convinced of these truths. Amazingly, God's word declares that there is a way for imperfect sinners to be perfected by God Himself. *"The LORD will perfect that which concerns me"* (Psalm 138:8).

This perfecting process begins with the gift of salvation through faith in Christ, which provides for us a perfect standing before God in heaven above. *"For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him . . . and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith"* (2 Corinthians 5:21 and Philippians 3:9). When humble, repentant sinners put their faith in Jesus,

they thereby stand before the Heavenly Father in the perfect righteousness of Christ.

God's perfecting process reaches a glorious conclusion when we believers eventually see the Lord face to face.

*"Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is"* (1 John 3:2). When we see the Lord in glory above, we shall be changed into the full likeness of Jesus, the perfect Son of God.

Meanwhile, during our life here on earth below, the Lord wants to be perfecting us -- developing in our daily Christian walk increasing measures of godliness and Christlikeness. For this we fully need the work of the Lord. *"Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?"* (Galatians 3:3). Growth in godliness is not a self-improvement project. It requires the work of the Holy Spirit in our hearts. So, we want to be prayerfully seeking the Lord Himself in His word day after day.

**GOD WANTS TO PERFECT YOUR LIFE!**

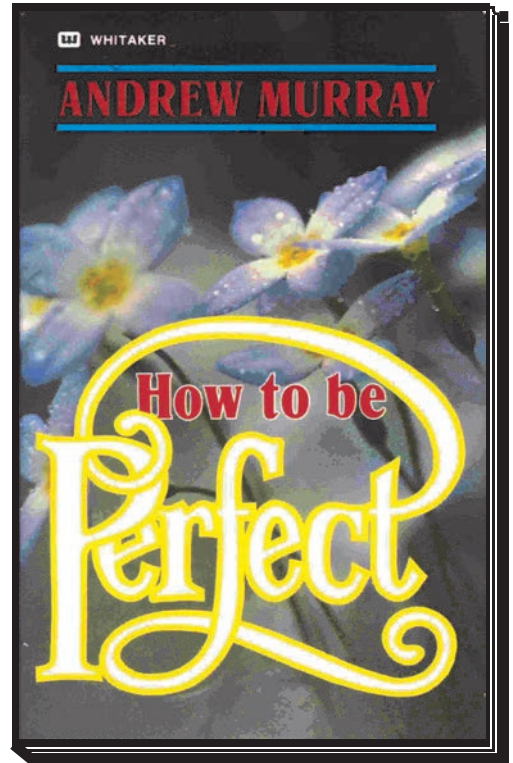
